Fire Code Fee Schedule

Master Planned Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems

The plan review and inspection fees within this schedule are applicable to master planned subdivisions/projects only.

Note: Fees are subject to change. Payment processing fees (credit card or ACH) are not included and will be added to your invoice if applicable.

Master Plan Approval: A master plan may be submitted for repeated residential fire sprinkler system installations. Once approved, the master plan may be reused for identical installations under the same design criteria. Master approvals are limited to the builder, model, and system type submitted. Use of a master plan for projects with differing water supply characteristics, elevations, or system demands may require additional review. Each unique model or system design shall require a separate master plan review.

Master Planned Subdivision Threshold: Master plan submittals are intended for residential developments utilizing repetitive building models and fire sprinkler system designs. For the purposes of this fee schedule, a master planned project is generally defined as **10 or more lots (or units)**. Projects with fewer than 10 lots, or those with multiple models or varying system designs, may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and may require separate plan reviews or additional fees. Lot counts shall include all phases of a development utilizing the master plan. Additional phases or expansions may be subject to additional fees.

Lot-Specific Approvals: Each installation requires a site-specific permit approval to verify address, water supply, and applicability of the approved master plan.

Plan Changes: Any deviations from the approved master plan, including layout, hydraulic demand, or system components, shall be submitted for additional review. Fees will be assessed based on the scope of changes. Such changes may void the master plan approval and require a new plan review.

Inspections: Inspection fees are assessed per home (unit), unless otherwise noted.

Wildfire Resiliency Code

The plan review and inspection fees within this schedule are applicable to wildfire resiliency (WUI) projects, including single lots, subdivisions, and master planned developments.
Note: Fees are subject to change. Payment processing fees (credit card or ACH) are not included and will be added to your invoice if applicable.

Plan Review: Projects in WUI zones require a review of building materials and site design.

Inspections: Inspections are required to verify site conditions, defensible space, and the installation of materials, including exterior siding, roofing, and window assemblies.

Structure Hardening: Focuses on construction materials and methods to make the building resistant to ignition from embers and flames (e.g., Roofing, Exterior Walls, Decking).

Site and Area: Focuses on reducing fuel loads around a structure to decrease fire intensity.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND FORMS FOR CONSTRUCTION

The fire district has contracted with 3E Fire Marshal Services to perform all services and duties as the district Fire Marshal.

Before the fire district will review site or building plans, the fire district **MUST** receive a completed Application for Plan Review, Impact Fee Form, and documentation of impact fee payment.

Prior to the Town of Keenesburg, Adams County or Weld County issuing a building permit, a copy of the completed Impact Fee Form, documentation of impact fee payment, and proof of fire district final review (comment letter/permit card or permit release letter) **MUST** be provided to them.

Plan review packets must include all documents and drawings necessary to verify compliance with the adopted fire code and referenced standards. For site plan reviews, the packet must include Civil Drawings (utility/fire protection water supply plan, required fire flow calculation, fire access and site plan). Review packet for new buildings must include architectural, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing plans. When fire protection systems are required, deferred submittals will be required.

Per IFC 104.7.2, the district may request technical assistance to determine the acceptability of technologies, processes, products, facilities, materials and uses attending the design, operation or use of a building or premises subject to inspection by the fire code official. The fire code official is authorized to require the owner or owner's authorized agent to provide, without charge to the jurisdiction, a technical opinion and report. The opinion and report shall be prepared by a qualified engineer, specialist, laboratory or fire safety specialty organization acceptable to the fire code official. and shall analyze the fire safety properties of the design, operation or use of the building or premises and the facilities and appurtenances situated thereon, to recommend necessary changes. The fire code official is authorized to require design submittals to be prepared by, and bear the stamp of, a registered design professional.

All submitted drawings must meet all requirements of the 2018 International Fire Code and referenced standards as adopted by Adams County, Weld County, and the Town of Keenesburg. The current edition of the referenced NFPA standards may be accepted if they do not lessen health, life and fire safety requirements.

One (1) PDF set of signed and stamped drawings and required supplementary documentation will need to be provided at the time of submittal.

3. Submit the Application for Plan Review and required documents electronically by sending them to weven@3efms.com.
4. Upon receipt of the Application for Plan Review and completion of the review, 3E Fire Marshall Services will invoice for payment.
5. Once all fees have been paid, the reviewed and stamped documents will be released to the applicant.
